



Loup Loup Ski Education Foundation “Season Pass for Work” Policy

The policy for securing a season pass in trade for hours spent volunteering at the Loup Loup Ski Area is as follows:

1. For full pass credit 40 hours of work are required for receipt of a full season pass. All 40 hours must be completed before a pass is issued and credit received will be calculated during the months worked for the following season only.
2. Partial credit may be earned for less than 40 hours of work completed. For every 4 hours worked a 10% share of a season pass is earned towards the purchase.
3. Work must be completed under the supervision of mountain management or under supervision of a member of the board of directors.
4. Work is to be conducted on a volunteer basis and the LLSEF assumes no responsibility for any injuries incurred while performing work, you are required to sign liability release before any work is started.
5. Proper documentation of hours worked will be required (time clock punched, sign-in sheet verified, etc.).
6. The person receiving the pass must perform the work. Work hours are non-transferable unless approved by management.
7. The LLSEF will provide opportunity to accumulate the required hours. However, we cannot guarantee unlimited availability. Workers must be willing to work when opportunities present themselves. The majority of these opportunities normally occur during May through November.
8. Because most work needed is physical in nature, all workers must be a minimum of 15 years of age and capable of engaging in physical labor (If under 18 years of age, this form must be signed by a parent or guardian).
9. An email address is required as we will be notifying by email and not making individual phone calls when work opportunities present themselves.
